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

It all came together in summer 2002, just weeks before the San Diego Comic Con. So we had little time to put together a "Sneak Preview" book in time for the con. Bill comes up with a seven-page, opening action sequence that can later easily segue to the next scene. Tone draws the pages in record time and Dreamer letters just as fast so we have the book in time for the opening night of Comic Con. But I'm getting head of myself....

The "sign".... Now, don't misunderstand, I know that producing this book was a great opportunity for Hurricane Entertainment. Signs are still a great thing.

With the seven pages roughed we call Debra Hill to arrange a meeting. We can't go ahead until we get the ok from John, Debra and Kurt, and we have 4 days left before the book has to get to the printer. I speak to Debra and let her know we have to meet that day. 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









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
